Through this Request for Qualifications/Proposals, the Authority seeks to engage a vendor as Ileostomy, Colostomy, G Tube, Tube feeding Products and Wound Care Products covered under Medicare Part B services from **March 1, 2022 to February 28, 2023**. This contract will be awarded through a fair and open process pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

The proposal must be received and will be publicly opened and read aloud on **December 7, 2021 at 2:00pm** at the GCIA administrative office located at 109 Budd Boulevard, Woodbury, New Jersey. The following is a description of the professional services needed including, where appropriate, a brief description of the tasks involved:

## **Ileostomy, Colostomy and Tube feeding Products**

Shady Lane has a need for a Medicare Part B Independent Consultant Provider on a monthly basis to provide Ileostomy, Colostomy, G Tube, Foley Catheters, Tube feeding Products and supplies for the residents of SLH.

The company will supply all residents who have an Ileostomy, Colostomy, G tubes, Foley Catheters, Tube Feedings and Wound Care Products with all products that are covered under Medicare Part B according to Medicare Part B guidelines.

The company will supply all residents who have a g-tube, peg tube feeding all their supplies including but not limited to the following, enteral feeding bags, syringes and specific enteral feedings for each and every month through Medicare Part B services.

A representative will come out to facility each and every month and meet with the Supplies Coordinator along with the Director of Nursing to see which residents are covered under Medicare Part B and leave documentation on the services provided for that month.

The ability to bill Medicare Part B.

All residents who are not covered under Medicare Part B services will be at the cost to SLH.

Cost of Services:

The Medicare Part B provider company works with the facility in the capacity of independent consultant and is an Independent Medicare Provider. Therefore, costs for services rendered and care provided to the resident are billed directly to Medicare Part B or appropriate private insurance carrier by the Specialist.

If additional supplies are needed for the residents of SLH it will be at the State Contract price and payable to the Medicare Part B Consultant.
