Through this Request for Qualifications/Proposals, the Authority seeks to engage a vendor as Rehabilitation Services for the term **March 1, 2022 to February 28, 2023**. This contract will be awarded through a fair and open process pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 19:44A-20.4 et seq.

The proposal must be received and will be publicly opened and read aloud on **December 7, 2021 at 2:00 P.M.** at the GCIA administrative office located at 109 Budd Boulevard, Woodbury, New Jersey. (See “Fair and Open Standardized Submission Requirements and Selection Criteria” for further information)

A Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist and Speech Therapist is needed to provide the Shady Lane Nursing Home residents in regards to such issues including but not limited to:

- ❑ Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapist and Speech Therapists that are licensed in the State of NJ.
- ❑ Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapist and Speech Therapists who will provide rehabilitation services for the residents of Shady Lane Home in accordance with Local, State and Federal Regulations.
- ❑ The Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapists and Speech Therapists will provide a copy of their current malpractice insurance.
- ❑ The ability to use the Sigma Care System for order writing and documentation for the residents of SLH.
- ❑ The Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Speech Therapists or his/her designee will notify the facility Administrator/Director of Nursing of any change in services, that affect the facility’s residents, including but not limited to any change in Therapist.
- ❑ The Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists and speech Therapists will attend mandatory resident care conferences.
- ❑ The Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Speech Therapists will participate in the care planning process.
- ❑ The Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Speech Therapists will maintain and update the resident medical record.
- ❑ The Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Speech Therapists will utilize the equipment supplied by the facility.
- ❑ Will attend weekly fall’s meetings with IDCT, as well as screening residents within 72 hrs of fall through the Sigma Care System.
- ❑ Assess resident upon admission/readmission, quarterly/and significant change in condition and appropriate changes in delivery of care in compliance with state/Federal regulations.
- ❑ Work with MDS Coordinator to pick best ARD for maximum RUG reimbursement through nursing and rehabilitation to bring resident to optimal level of independence.
- ❑ To initiate a Nursing Restorative Program with working with the MDS Coordinator.
- ❑ Monthly meetings with Restorative Nurse for possible changes in the program.
- ❑ Braces/Splints will have residents name engraved or labeled.
- ❑ Will be in charge of w/c, walker, and commode any DME equipment for resident use and will store information into a book for SLH use for distribution to residents when needed.
- ❑ Quarterly meetings with rehab team.
