

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Bioenergy Devco, LLC, based in Annapolis, Maryland, has made application to the County of Gloucester to amend the Gloucester County Solid Waste Management Plan for the incorporation into the Solid Waste Management Plan of a Class C Recycling Center. The facility will accept a maximum of 450 tons per day at the proposed Anaerobic Digestion facility to be located at 107 Gilbreth Parkway in Mantua Township on a 10-acre site on a portion of three separate lots identified as Block 261, Lots 3, 9.02 and 10 in Mantua Township with access from Block 1 Lots 4 and 5 in Harrison Township in Gloucester County. The proposed facility is located within the South Jersey Technology Park at Rowan University on Rt. 322.

The proposed facility will accept Class C Recyclable Materials (food wastes) for purposes of anaerobic digestion and the production of gas for distribution into the nearby pipelines. The facility, upon incorporation into the Gloucester County Solid Waste Management Plan, will seek all applicable approvals from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

In addition, the proposed facility will receive and process 120,000 tons per year, or an average of 2,450 tons per week on a 7-day week processing basis. This would average approximately 350 tons per day with a maximum of 450 tons per day. The applicant desires to limit the throughput to 2,450 tons per week. The facility will run 24 hours per day, but will accept materials on approximately a six day a week schedule (Monday through Saturday). The facility seeks to be permitted to accept up to 60 tons on Sunday, in the event that certain customers will need special deliveries. All vehicles (including employees) will enter the location via Edison Parkway/Gilbreth Parkway directly from Rt 322 (Mullica Hill Road).
